

DIAGNOSING YOUR ITCHY DOG: THE ROUTE TO COMFORT.

THESE ARE STEPS YOUR VETERINARIAN WILL TAKE TO DIAGNOSE YOUR DOG'S PROBLEM QUICKLY AND ACCURATELY:

History	Review your dog's history and look for obvious problems (such as scabies, flea allergy)
Tests	Laboratory testing to check for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Parasites- Infection
